On August 27, 2024, we issued an RFQ for the resurfacing of the Jeffrey Park Tennis Courts, removal of the lights and installation of drainage. Upon the deadline of September 13, 2024 we received just one proposal from Sheedy. At the time, given the limited number of proposals, we decided to reissue an RFQ, which was done on November 8, 2024. By the December 13, 2024 deadline we had received three proposals. The following shows the proposals we received for the project:

The asphalt tennis court resurfacing is the focus of the project with the electrical work and drain being alternates. As you can see, Sheedy provided pricing that includes electric work that will need to be done when the current lights are removed. Electrical work will need to be done to reconnect electric service to the park restrooms and park cabin as well as potential future tennis/pickleball lighting. We don't anticipate moving forward on the drain work.

With all of that said, Sheedy pricing for the asphalt work was the lowest by a fairly large margin. Sheedy's tennis sub is Total Tennis, which has a great deal of experience with tennis court resurfacing. As a result, I am recommending that we move forward with Sheedy for the resurfacing of the tennis courts, removal of the exhibiting lights and electrical work for this project.
