# Year of the Parks – Commonwealth Park Community Workshop – Monday, March 6<sup>th</sup>

- Bexley City Hall will host the Commonwealth Park Community Workshop on Mon., Mar. 6<sup>th</sup> from 6p-7:30p.
- This will be a three part workshop:
  - o Public Workshop for the Columbia Project Design
    - We have engaged MKSK to develop the design for the Columbia Street project between Commonwealth East and West. This public workshop will be an opportunity for the community to provide input for the design process.
  - Commonwealth Park Arboretum and Pond Update
    - This will be an opportunity for the community to review the arboretum and pond design and provide feedback.
  - o Update on the Commonwealth Park Master Plan, which was approved back in 2018
    - The Columbia and Arboretum Projects were both called for within the approved Commonwealth Park Master Plan.
