

Recreation Board Meeting:

- The Recreation Board met on Wed., Feb. 8th at 5:30p at the Senior Center
 - The board approved a \$40 senior pool membership rate.
 - The board was updated on the Alcohol Framework Resolution discussion that took place at City Council on Feb. 7th.
 - o The board assigned Ann Brennan to fill the vacant seat on the Senior Advisory Committee.

Year of the Parks – Update:

- Bexley City Hall will host the Commonwealth Park Community Workshop on Mon., Mar. 6th from 6p-7:30p. Items of discussion/review:

 - o Commonwealth Park Arboretum and Pond Update
 - o Update on the overall Commonwealth Park Master Plan
- We have put together a small working group of residents that are skate board enthusiast with the goal of evaluating the potential for the installation of a community skate park.
 - We have identified potential space at Schneider Park and will be working on engaging a design team to help us through the process.



- Registration for returning families opened online on Feb. 6th. That day we reached a tentative waitlist for all three summer camp programs.
 - Families are required to submit the weeks they want by Fri., Feb. 24th, at which point we will look to open additional weeks to those on the waitlist.

Pool Membership:
