Meetings and Progress Over Past Couple Weeks:

- Pond should be complete in late September

BCF Grant Awards

This month, we received good news on several grants that had been applied for or where fundraising is underway. This included:

- \$30,000 in grant funding for the Drexel Avenue median tree plantings and hardscape
- \$23,000 in grant funding for the Schneider Park birch walk and landscape infill
- News that the BCF is close to completing its \$500,000 YOTP commitment, thanks in part to a recent gift of \$150,000 towards the project
- A variety of smaller grants received through the 2nd round grant awards for 2023

Trinity Redevelopment Update

In September, the proposed development at 2200 E Main received preliminary review at the architectural review board and the tree and public gardens commission. The earliest next expected hearing will be in October, at the next ARB meeting.
