Columbus Marathon – The marathon was a success. We had eight officers on overtime working the route through Bexley.

Citizens Police Academy – Lt. Holdren presented Criminal Investigations in the 6th week of the academy. During this presentation, the class had the opportunity to process a fake crime scene.

Members of the Bexley Mayor’s Court (Marquan Stewart, Leslie Albeit, and Garret Carr) conducted a panel for the academy participants in week 7.

CERT – Columbus Fire Department and Bexley resident, Ian Garriott, presented Fire Safety and Utility Controls. Students were able to use a fire extinguisher to put out a small fire.

Lt. Overly is working with Franklin County Emergency Management to organize a disaster exercise for the final class.

Detective Bureau – The Bureau has been assisting the patrol units with extra patrols around the city due to current events. Along with that they continue to manage their caseloads. Det. Briley and Det. Byrd continue to assist with teaching CPR and first aid as part of the HEARTSafe Bexley program. They are also wrapping up their background investigations for police applicants.

Detectives also submitted three cases to be presented to the grand jury, three items went to the lab for investigations and they conducted one well being checked. Detectives also received information back from Apple Inc. that was requested via subpoena. This information was forwarded to a prosecutor to help with prosecution.
