#### **Street Department:**

The crews have finished the leaf collection program, three trips were completed throughout the city. The crews are currently working leaf removal in the alleys and general alley clean-up.

#### **Water and Sewer Department:**

The Water/Sewer crew has been working on videoing the city's main lines and looking for issues and identifying lines for future lining projects. Also, the crew is working on a back log of MTU replacements.

#### **Urban Forestry/Grounds Maintenance:**

The crews are doing tree maintenance and ground work throughout the city. Also, the crews have starting working on stump removals.

#### **Drexel Project**

Drexel-Main to Broad-The project is wrapped for the winter season. The tree up lighting project is currently in progress. The new crosswalk RFB has been added at Powell and Drexel.

#### **2024 Sewer Lining Project**

Currently working on the bid package.

#### **2023 Street Project**

The project has been delayed until spring.

#### **Grandon Ave- Water Line Project**

The project is complete other the pavement portion, which will take place in the spring.

**Chelsea Ave-Water Line Project**

The project is underway, which includes sewer improvements and new water main line. The project will be complete in the spring.

**Some of the 2023 Highlights from the Service Department**

- 20,000 sf feet of concrete sidewalk was replaced
- 4,000 linear feet of concrete curb was replaced
- 4,300 liner feet of new water main line was replaced
- 145 water service lines were replaced
- 10,000 lineal feet of sanitary and storm lines were lined
- 162 trees were planted throughout the city
- There were multiple spot brick repairs throughout the city
- 5 fire hydrants were replaced
- 10 water leaks were repaired
