PROPOSED AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 6 - 24

An ordinance establishing the Craig Kleiman Fund to Support Families with Special Needs, designed to receive donations intended for the provision of support and services for families facing special needs and challenges and to authorize matching funds from unencumbered General Fund appropriations in the Mayor's Office budget for special needs up to \$5,000 in donations.

<u>Whereas:</u> The City periodically receives donations to be used to benefit residents and families with special needs residing in the City; and

<u>Whereas</u>: It is the desire of the City to keep these funds separate to be used specifically for the benefit of Bexley's residents and families with special needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY.

Section1.

That a special revenue fund titled the Craig Kleiman Fund to Support Families with Special Needs is hereby established to receive donations to be used for support and services for Bexley residents and families with special needs.

Section 2.

To authorize matching funds from General Fund appropriations in the Mayor's Office budget for special needs up to \$5,000 in donations.

Section 3.

That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
