

Service Department Update Service Director Andy Bashore April 23rd, 2024

Street Department:

The crews are working on pothole repairs and prepping asphalt patches for the spring. They have also started working on sidewalk repairs.

Water and Sewer Department:

The Water/Sewer crew has finished the annual catch basin cleaning program. Also, the crew is working on a backlog of MTU replacements.

Urban Forestry/Grounds Maintenance:

The crews are doing tree maintenance and groundwork throughout the city. They have also started mulching and planting flowers, and the mowing season has begun.

Drexel Project

Drexel-Main to Broad- The tree up lighting project is complete. The street has been striped for lane marking and parking. At CSG, the curb lane and catch basin have been adjusted to allow extra room in the pick-up line for vehicles headed south.

Bids are back and under review.

Grandon Ave- Water Line Project

The project is complete, except for the pavement portion, which will occur in late May.

Chelsea Ave-Water Line Project

The project includes sewer improvements and a new water main line.

The project will be completed in the spring.

The bids are back and under review.

Service Department Highlights

- -Multiple brick repairs have been made around the city, and crews are still working on them.
- -Finalized the contract with Franklin Soil and Water for 2024.
- -Completed and submitted the City's 2024 Ms4 permit to the Ohio EPA.
- -Our second Ford Lighting will be arriving soon.
- -Sewer work is underway at Stanbery, which includes cleaning and relining.
