GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

- LinkUs East/West Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Line: Participated in 60% design kick-off meeting with COTA and consultants Kimley-Horn to determine next steps to address Bexley's concerns, including planning for an on- and off-street parking study on Main Street to be completed by May; Local betterments (additional projects beyond the scope of the transit improvements) to be identified in the coming months; Outreach plan also forthcoming
- Bexley Mural Fest: Call for Mural Fest artists currently underway
 with artist applications due May 3 (20 artists have applied thus far);
 Also seeking Mural Fest sponsors and wall hosts (Bexley Community
 Foundation has already claimed the Title Sponsorship Level \$10,000):

• **Public Electric Vehicle Charging Stations:** Internal work group preparing to bid out electrical work needed to install five non-networked charging stations (with 10 total charging heads); Payment and enforcement likely to be managed with ParkMobile (TBD)

- Holztman Landfill: Engaged with KMK Law (Keating Muething & Klekamp PLL) legal counsel for Ferndale-Mayfield area property owners; Up next: Working toward entering into an agreement to jointly pursue funding for further environmental testing
- **Business Liaising:** Met with Clean Title in April; Planning to begin coordinated business retention and expansion (BRE) visits in late spring
