An Ordinance to Approve the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge No. 9 and the City of Bexley

Whereas, patrol officers and sergeants in the Bexley Police Department are represented by the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge No. 9 (FOP) for purposes of collective bargaining; and

Whereas, the collective bargaining agreement between FOP and the City expired on December 31, 2023; and

Whereas, the parties have been engaged in negotiations for a successor collective bargaining agreement in accordance with Chapter 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

Whereas, the parties have reached a tentative agreement on a successor collective bargaining agreement to be effective from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Bexley City Council hereby approves the successor collective bargaining agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement.

<u>Section 2</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and shall go into full force and effect upon the approval of the Mayor.
