Flock Camera Update - Installation has been delayed and will begin sometime in July.

Law Enforcement Training – Sergeant Fleming completed the Law Enforcement Foundation's three-month long Supervisor Training and Education Program (STEP). This training focuses on nineteen different modules designed to help first line supervisors.

Detective Bureau – The Bureau continues to work through cases new and old. Last month the detective bureau submitted one item to BCI for analysis, submitted three cases to be presented for indictment and presented three cases in front of the Grand Jury. Along with this they also filed eight subpoenas for information.

Detective Byrd continues to work through many ID fraud cases including a case with a large amount of stolen checks and IDs. Detective Briley and Detective Sergeant Otte rode in the community "Ride to Work" event which aims to raise money for local student athletes. They also attended the Ohio

Peace Officer Memorial ceremony in London, Ohio as part of the Bexley Police Honor Guard. Sergeant Otte spent a large part of his time last month investigating several swatting calls that were aimed at a Bexley resident. A warrant was finally issued for the suspect who was arrested by another local agency. The suspects phones were seized pursuant to a search warrant and are currently at the cyber lab for analysis.
