

Recreation Board Meeting:

- The Recreation Board met on Tue., June 4th at 5:30p at City Hall.
 - The board discussed the pickleball lights and took a vote on approving lights at the pickleball courts. The board voted 5-1 in favor of a resolution supporting the addition of lights at the pickleball courts, replacement of the tennis court lights with new modern lighting, adjustment to the hours of operation for the tennis and pickleball courts to 8a-9p, and ongoing monitoring of the impact of noise and light pollution with the goal of working toward mitigation for the betterment of the neighbors, park visitors, and park wildlife.

Park Signage - Update:

- We received three bids on the park sign package with Columbus Sign coming in at the lowest and best bid at \$105,831.21.
- The Board of Controls approved the selection of Columbus Sign at a meeting on May 14th.
- We are working with Columbus Sign on the contract and the details on the scope with the goal of sign installation in the fall of 2024.

Pool Opening:

- Pool Memberships as of June 24th:
 - o 2024 memberships sold 3640 (2023 Total 3635)
- Pool Opening Weekend
 - Weather was nice and overall we had a good opening weekend.
 - We have had and are still having issues with the splash pad at the pool. Patterson Pools was out to address the issue, but were not able to find a solution and are scheduled to be back out again this week.



- Opening weekend saw a high number of saves by the guards. These were all routine saves, but we followed up with an email to members with reminders about rules and tips to help keep their children safe.
- Unfortunately, as can be the case when managing a facility such as the pool, we have had a
 handful of incidents during the course of the summer resulting from those in attendance not
 following the rules and direction from the guards. This has included vandalism in our boy's
 restroom and disrespect shown to the staff, by adults and youth, as they work to enforce
 rules and keep patrons safe.
 - Communication was sent to all members encouraging parents to talk with kids about appropriate behavior and to encourage adults to support staff as they work to enforce facility rules.
- We appreciate all of the continued support as the staff has worked extremely hard to provide a fun and safe facility for our community. Thank you to all of the staff that worked this past week during the extreme heat!
