2013

- 5 families started a Fund at the Columbus Foundation with \$50,000 to support philanthropic projects in Bexley in 1999.
- In 2010, we formalized into our own Foundation and in 2011, received 96 donations totaling over \$200,000 from community members.
- Today, we have \$2.8 million in assets and receive 650 donations annually.
- Our vision is to create a vibrant community for all who live, learn, work, play and care in Bexley now and in the future.
- Our Mission is to enhance the quality of life for the Bexley community through investing in initiatives that make a positive impact.

To date we have awarded over \$5 million by funding over 250 grants in gifts ranging from \$500 to \$1.75 million.


