

ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 24

An ordinance to amend the pay range for Deputy Chief of Police

WHEREAS: Council approved the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Fraternal Order of the Police for 2024-2026 which included market adjustments for members of the bargaining unit; and

WHEREAS: The reposition of Deputy Chief of Police is not a member of within the bargaining unit and therefore a market adjustment for this reposition was not included in the approved collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS: Without a market adjustment, the Deputy Chief of Police salary range will not have sufficient separation between that of the Lieutenant rank;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1.

That the annual pay rate of Deputy Chief of Police be amended from \$146,390 to \$149,625 to provide a similar market adjustment to that received by Sergeants and Lieutenants in the 2024-26 FOP contract.

Section 2.

That this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law, and that the provisions in Section 1 be retroactive to January 1, 2024.
