


Recreation Board Meeting:

- The Recreation Board met on Wed., Nov. 6th.
- Lauren Miller presented the board with the 2024 Jeffrey Mansion Rental Year End Report.
- The board approved updated rental rates set to go in effect on Jan. 1, 2025.
- The board is set to meet on Wed., Dec. 4th at 530p at City Hall. The board will be presented with the 2025 Senior Center report by Kristen Schweitzer.

Harvest Festival:

- The Annual Bexley Harvest Festival was held on Fri., Oct. 18th at Jeffrey Park.
- It was a beautiful night with very strong attendance. Attendance estimate was 1500 visitors.
- The event was extended by 30 minutes, which allowed us to run more hay rides and provide more time for visitors to experience the variety of activities.

2024 Jeffrey Mansion Rental – Year End Report Highlights:

- Paid Rentals 77
 - o 10% Increase compared to 2023 (70)
- Total Rental Revenue \$158,344
 - o 3% increase compared to 2023 (\$153,479)
- 54 Resident Rentals and 23 Non-Resident Rentals
- 2025 Look Ahead
 - On pace to have similar rental numbers in 2025 compared to 2024.
- Fee Structure:

- Since the opening of the New Carriage Court Space in 2021, we have not increased rental rates to date.
- o In reviewing rental rate comps, we found that with increases we would still be competitive in the market.
- Looked at what would equate to a roughly 3-5% inflationary increase over the past 4 years and recommended to the board increase accordingly.
- In an effort to continue to make the space available to the community for smaller events such as birthday parties or graduation parties, we did not increase the resident rates for Sunday events.
