An ordinance to appropriate \$5,411,860 from the OPWC project fund to record 2025 expenses related to the "South Cassingham Road, Montrose Avenue and South Remington Road Comprehensive Improvements" project

Whereas, the City has received funding from the Ohio Public Works Commission for the "South Cassingham Road, Montrose Avenue and South Remington Road Comprehensive Improvements" project in the form of a \$5,411,860 loan and grant program, and

Whereas, this project will include water line replacement, asphalt resurfacing, and road and sidewalk safety improvements; and

funds are disbursed directly from OPWC as disbursement requests are Whereas. authorized, but nonetheless must be appropriated and recorded by the City; and

Whereas, it is necessary to appropriate funds in order to record 2025 expenses related to these projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1.

That \$5,411,860 is hereby appropriated from the OPWC Project Fund in order to record 2025 expenses related to the "South Cassingham Road, Montrose Avenue and South Remington Road Comprehensive Improvements" project.

Section 2.

That all unexpended appropriation shall be re-appropriated at the beginning of each successive year until the project is complete.

Section 3.

That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
