- **3b** For future projects, please provide a site plan in an architectural or engineering scale such as 1"=10' or 1"=20'.
- 3f Shrubs in Right of Way along Stanbery are existing. Proposed plantings begin at the corner and continue north along Maryland. Proposed plantings are out of the line of sight triangle for traffic.

Owners requested a perennial garden but is it recommended that evergreens be strategically interwoven into the perennial garden to provide winter interest and to screen the stone wall. The remaining planting material is appropriate for the site conditions.

Note that the design provides an approximate 3' wide lawn strip between the sidewalk and planting bed.
