I am inquiring about our curb lawn/tree issues at our house. Our address is 222 N. Remington. We have two large trees that completely block all light from getting to our curb lawn, this we have no grass (EVER) and it is a complete mud pit.

One of the trees has a root system that has also torn up our driveway and approach, to the point that the city has replaced our sidewalk and driveway approach. Grant Archer came out to assess the situation about a week ago, so please inquire with him, too.

We are interested in getting a new driveway and potentially selling our home. However, the lack of grass/mud pit situation/tree roots would not bode well for pictures or interested buyers.
