An ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with St. Charles Preparatory School to provide a Bexley police officer to work as a school resource officer to St. Charles for the 2025-2026 school year

WHEREAS, a City of Bexley police officer has been assigned as a school resource officer to St. Charles Preparatory School for the past several school years; and

WHEREAS, St. Charles is desirous of continuing to use a Bexley police officer as a school resource officer; and

WHEREAS, St. Charles has agreed to pay the entire cost for the school resource officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1.

That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with St. Charles for the City to continue providing a school resource officer for St. Charles during the 2025-2026 school year.

Section 2.

That the Mayor is additionally authorized to enter into subsequent agreements with St. Charles provided such agreements are on substantially the same terms as the 2025-2026 agreement and St. Charles continues to pay the full cost of the school resources officer.

Section 2.

Third Reading:

That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health and welfare of the City of Bexley and its residents and shall go into effect upon approval by the Mayor.
