

ORDINANCE NO. 30-25

An ordinance to appropriate \$130,000 from the General Fund to the Grants and Donations Account in order to provide supplemental appropriations for grants that have been awarded

Whereas: The City has been awarded multiple grants for 2025 projects, including recent grants awarded for the Fair Avenue median improvements (\$50,000), Pickleball Court lights (\$75,000), Clifton Avenue Tree Plantings (\$34,000), and new lights for the Bexley Community Christmas tree (\$10,000); and

Whereas: While an effort is made to appropriate funds each year to offset anticipated grant income, it is challenging to fully anticipate the grant funds that will be awarded in any given year, as grant opportunities are identified and pursued throughout the year; and

Whereas: Many grants are awarded on a reimbursement basis, and it is necessary to appropriate funds in order to complete the grant-funded projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1.

That \$130,000 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund into the Grants and Donations account for the purpose of paying for grant-funded projects.

Section 2.

That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
