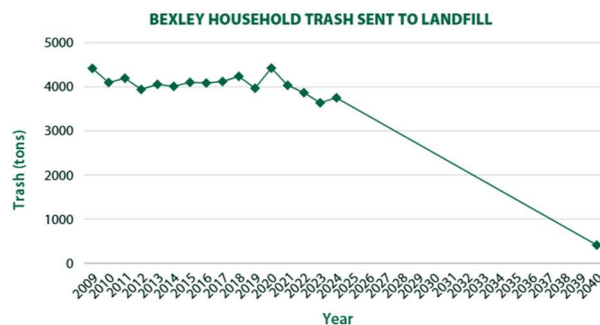
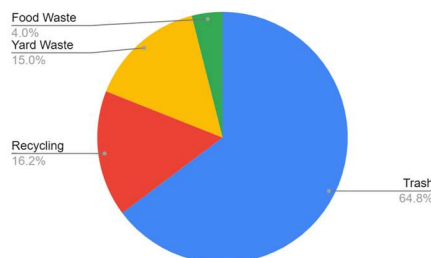

Which interpretation should we use?



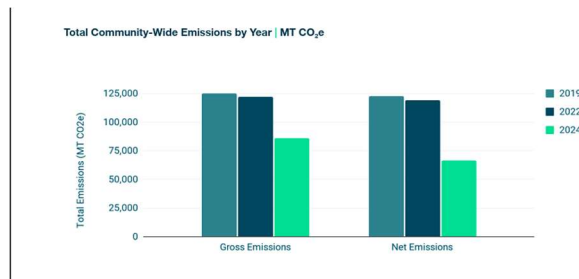

2024 saw 85,773 metric tons CO₂e gross emissions; 66,226 net emissions after forestry and aggregation RECs

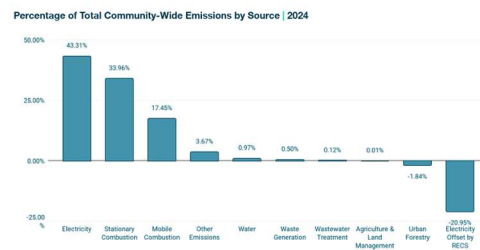
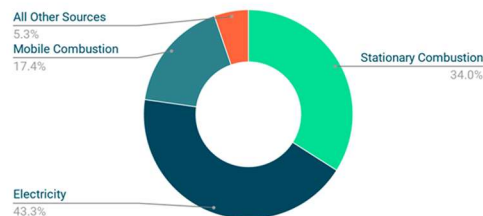
