



1	<p>Pros</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Parade route• Walkers – both immediate neighbors and Bexley residents• Shade trees• Kids playing area for generations; baseball, soccer, football, digging• Referred to as “The Island”• 1970s-80s was heavily used by kids; not as much now due to lack of lawn and surface roots; it was noted that young families in Bexley tend to be cyclical• Buffer for houses on west side
2	<p>Cons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No place to sit, especially because of mud• Wayfinding; stop signs confusing; general traffic flow confusing• Fast north-south traffic along Roosevelt• Poor drainage• Difficult walking due to divots and surface roots• No cross walks going east-west; have to walk around the tip of the medians• Fall leaf removal; concern with dust and dirt• Skunk and opossums but not deer present

3	<p>Desires</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Something interesting to draw into space; seating • Place for neighbors to meet • Smooth/flat area to walk dogs • Dog poop trash can at south end • Perennial beds • Curvilinear paths • Maintain brick aesthetic • Maintain areas of lawn • No additional lights are needed • Maintain safety; if shrubs are introduced, they should be low • Keep area open for seating during July 4th parade • Seasonal interest of plants • Desire to keep up with maintenance of area • Noted that moveable furniture might 'walk off' • Flowers at end caps • Seat walls at end caps • Metal street signs • Free Little Library • Plant Library • Future volunteers to help maintain area
