Overview

This report provides an operational update on current work across all Service Department divisions, including Street, Water & Sewer, Urban Forestry/Grounds Maintenance, and Utilities.

Departmental Updates

Street Department

- Crews have completed a second pass of leaf removal throughout the City and are currently progressing through the third round.
- Concrete repair work is being finalized in key areas.
- Crews were out Saturday and Sunday 12/13&12/14 for snow removal.

Water and Sewer Department

- Teams are actively engaged in the Lead Line Inventory Program to ensure compliance with state and federal requirements.
- Crews are also cleaning and camera-inspecting main lines to improve system performance and identify maintenance needs.

Urban Forestry & Grounds Maintenance

- Ongoing tree maintenance and general grounds upkeep is being performed across the city.
- Crews have begun stump removal operations as part of regular forestry management.

Utility Department

- The utility team is working on replacing street signs and repairing/upgrading street lights in multiple areas of the City.

2025 Street Project

- **Status:** Complete.

2025 Sidewalk Project

- **Status:** Nearing completion, with all work expected to conclude later this month.

North Columbia Project

- **Status:** Complete.

South Remington Water Line Project

- **Status:** In progress.
- Work is currently focused on the block between Astor and Mound.
- The waterline portion is anticipated to be completed by late Spring 2026, followed by paving.

Columbia Gas Project

- Columbia Gas crews are operating on Euclaire, Charles, and South Cassingham.
- Completion is expected within two weeks.
