A Resolution establishing the scheduling of Independence Day celebrations, including the parade and evening fireworks display.

WHEREAS, The City of Bexley hosts, bar none, the finest and most enthusiastic celebration of the Fourth of July; and

WHEREAS, the date of celebration of the festivities has been held on the fourth of July in recent years; and

WHEREAS, it is the expressed desire of the Mayor, Bexley City Council, and the leadership of the Bexley Celebrations & Events Committee to provide for a consistent, reliable, and equitable formula for determining the appropriate date on which to host community Fourth of July celebrations; and

WHEREAS, the safety of our community is the foremost priority when planning all events and celebrations, and working closely with City leadership and the Chief of Police is vital to ensure Independence Day celebrations are scheduled appropriately, consistently, and safely for all;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bexley, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City of Bexley Independence Day parade shall be held on the Fourth of July, regardless of which day of the week it may fall.

Section 2. That the City of Bexley Independence Day evening festivities and fireworks display will be scheduled annually by the Mayor in consultation with the Bexley Celebrations and Events Committee and the Chief of Police.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
