## Documentation:

- 1. Statement of Support of Demolition
- 2. Existing site plan
- 3. Plan and assessment for reuse

Determination for evaluation of Preservation Significance:

(1) Historically **OR** Architecturally Significance AND (2) Worthy of Preservation

by the Architecture Review Board

## Criteria to Determine Preservation Significance:

- 1. Age and Condition
- 2. Quality of Design

**YES** 

- 3. Importance to the Neighborhood
- 4. Significance of Structure to Development
- 5. Impact on Property tax

Evaluation based on the above criteria by Architectural Review Board Determines:

## Structure IS NOT Historically or Architecturally Significant and Worthy of Preservation

Applicant requests

Architectural Review and

Certificate of Appropriateness for

Proposed Replacement from ARB

IF ONLY (1) or (2)

Structure IS Historically or Architecturally Significant and Worthy of Preservation

Additional Criteria to Determine Cause for Demolition

Evaluation of Substantial Economic Hardship:

- 1. Reduction of property value
- 2. Unreasonable maintenance cost
- 3. Restoration/preservation imposes unreasonable costs

OR

Evaluation of Unusual and Compelling Circumstances:

- 1. Structurally not feasible
- 2. Replacement plan is superior to existing structure
- 3. Replacement plan more contextually compatible
- 4. Existing structure has adverse effect on neighbors
