Capital University Game Day Observation – Nov. 4, 2017

Staff conducted a partial Game Day observation of general conditions on November 4,2017. This was the official annual audit covering the following sections outlined in the Conditions of Approval, for a game with an anticipated attendance over 700:

- Game Day and Night Traffic Management
- Game Day and Night Parking Management
- Safety Management

Game Day:

Observations were made between 12:30 PM and 3:30 PM both before and during a Capital home football game versus Marietta College. Kickoff was scheduled for 1:30 PM. The attendance was 1953 according to the university website :http://athletics.capital.edu/sports/fball/2017-18/boxscores/20171104 9449.xml

Weather: Cloudy, 57 degrees with a light breeze.

Conditions of Approval conformance:

- 1. Game Day and Night Traffic Management
 - The Main St. permanent parking signage has been installed .
 - The temporary signage was in place as required for anticipated crowds over 700 .
 - All of the busses were parked in designated areas .
 - Attendants were in place before the game to direct traffic to designated oncampus lots (observations made between 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM).
- 2. Game Day and Night Traffic Management
 - Designated on-campus lots were utilized
 - Staff observed, but did not count the parking in the lots. Lots S1 and S2 were
 full with only a few spots unoccupied. Lot S2 had limited empty spaces.
 There was limited availability of on-street parking within one block south of
 Mound St., including Pleasant Ridge, Francis and Astor. Along Main St.,
 near the Bexley Library, there were available parking spaces open. Streets
 more than a block east or west had significant available spaces.

3. Stadium Light Management

• Not applicable to this observation .

4. Stadium Sound Management

- No significant amplified sound heard before kick-off .
- No prohibited sounds, air cannons or air horns, observed during event.

5. Safety Management

- Staff observed a minimum of 6 officers, 4 Capital University Police and 2 City of Bexley Police Officers were on duty during the game, in conformance with the conditions of approval for a game with over 1,000 in attendance.
- One City of Bexley cruiser and 1 Capital University Police cruiser were observed to be patrolling the streets in the area before and during the game.
