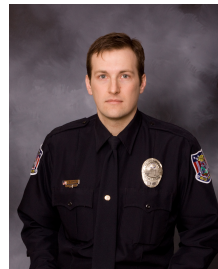


#### **Bexley Community Cleanup Day is April 16th**
