


Key Updates:

Bexley Green Team Update

The City has received a grant from SWACO to conduct a "zero waste plan". A zero waste plan creates a long-term blueprint for diverting waste away from landfills. The green team is being put together with the current proposed balance of members:

- Council Service Committee Chair
- School District rep
- Capital U. rep
- 2 Chamber of Commerce reps (1 representing a smaller business, 1 representing a "larger" business)
- 3 interested residents
- 2 representatives from the City administration

Please let me know if you have any input on the membership mix, or know of any residents who might be interested in being a resident rep. The green team process should be a 6 month process, and will include public input sessions. Upon completion, the zero waste plan will be submitted to City Council for review and approval.

The City has received a grant for the development of community garden plots in north Bexley, adjacent to the Police Station.

Shredding/ Rx Drug Drop Off / Hazardouse Waste Event on Saturday, October 22nd from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm @ Delmar Drive

We're offering a brand new opportunity this fall for residents to safely and conveniently dispose of shredding, hazardous waste, and prescription drugs. Hazardous Waste disposal can be difficult, and this is the first event of its kind in Bexley. And prescription drug disposal has become increasingly important, especially as we <u>unite in efforts to help combat the opiate epidemic</u> by reducing access to unused pain medication.

The event will be held on Delmar Drive at the City's service garage and police department facilities. The following materials will be accepted for safe disposal:

- Shredding (collected by Shred-It and shredded offsite)
- Prescription Drugs (DEA sponsored event)
- Batteries
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Lawn Chemicals and Fertilizers
- Oil-based paint, stains, polishes
- Motor Oil
- Spray Paint
- Old Gasoline
- Insecticides
- Anti-Freeze
