
Athletic Fields Public Workshop Recap

December 7th's meeting had good feedback from area residents and users of athletics and the community garden. Today we met with community garden representatives regarding plans to relocate approximately 22 plots from the west side of the garden to the north side. The new plots will be raised beds.

The Recreation and Parks Department will also hold a separate open house on Saturday, December 17th from 9-10am inside a heated tent on the field next to the Community Garden just north of Ferndale and Mayfield. Doughnuts and coffee will be provided. Residents will have the opportunity to review the draft design and provide any feedback/suggestions.
