Citizen Complaint Process

I want to overview the process that is involved if a complaint is filed against a City employee or elected official. First off, residents can fill out complaint forms in person at City Hall or the Police Department, or online at www.bexley.org/complaint. Complaints come to my office and are handled in conjunction with the appropriate department. If a complaint is filed against an elected official, it will be handed over to the City Attorney, who will oversee the investigation and response to the complaint. If a citizen is not satisfied with the response to a complaint, they will be notified that they can contact the Ohio Attorney General's Office, the Ohio Civil Rights Commission, or any other appropriate agency or resource depending on the nature of the complaint.

SB 311 Update
