

# Mayor's Update to City Council March 27, 2018

## South Roosevelt Construction has Commenced

The reconstruction of South Roosevelt Avenue from Main Street to Broad Street began last week and will last approximately 5 months. The project will begin at Broad and Roosevelt moving south, doing one block at a time. During this time, there will be parking restrictions posted on the street during working hours (7:00am to 6:00pm) on weekdays. We will maintain access to residences to the extent feasible but there will be occasions when travel through S. Roosevelt Avenue or Powell Avenue or Dale Avenue will not be accessible, particularly during water main installation and paving. This is usually limited to the area where the crews are working and access may be available by going around the block from the opposite direction. This project is made possible thanks to a combination grant and zero-interest loan from the Ohio Public Works Commission.
