Jazz in the Park launches

Jazz in the Park launched at Havenwood Memorial Day weekend with a crowd of approximately 1,200. The series continues on the afternoon of the last Sunday in June through August at 4:00 pm.

Roosevelt and 4th of July

Roosevelt contractors are wrapping up water connections. Paving is scheduled to occur prior to the 4th of July, in order to provide good pavement conditions for the parade. Weather conditions can create schedule variables, so there are backup plans in place to ensure a safe surface if repaving cannot occur in time.
