Development Updates:

- 396 N Cassady
 - o Mint lce Cream Parlor has pulled out of project
 - o Back-up user is putting together plans for ARB/BZAP review
- Freshii
 - o Freshii space is under construction at former Bruegger's space
- Bexley Premier Restaurant
 - o Restaurant has not received occupancy permit. Rumors of operations at the location are being looked into.
- Ferndale/Mayfield environmental status
 - Several meetings have been had with Franklin County Public Health to determine whether the testing conducted to date can be used to require landlords to test their own properties. Our team is providing FCPH with some follow-up information, but it looks like we are going to be moving forward with a program to do so. More details to follow.
