Further Developing the Bexley Bike Plan

Bexley Diversity & Inclusion Collaborative Update:

The D&I Collaborative has met for several years now, and has recently completed a strategic planning process. I recently met with leaders from the other participating institutions, and we felt that the jurisdiction and scope of the group continued to be unclear. We felt that instead of continuing with a multi-jurisdictional group, that it would make most sense to incorporate the goals of the strategic plan into the individual strategic plans of the member organizations, namely the City, the school district, and the library, and to call upon community input and assistance in the form of more focused task forces structured around specific initiatives and programming. The alternative that had been identified would have been to transition the collaborative to a more formalized, appointed committee. Thinking through how that would function as an appointed committee of the City but with membership of multiple stakeholder organizations, it became clear that mission confusion would continue, and that the new committee would require additional staff support from the City in an

environment where our committee support resources are fully strained. I plan on bringing an ordinance to council at the beginning of the year, incorporating the recommendations into the City strategic plan. Additionally, I will be working on an overall update of the strategic plan for 2020.
