### COVID-19 Preparedness

We are closely monitoring guidance received from Franklin County Public Health & Columbus Health Department, who are leading regional monitoring and public health efforts relative to the Coronavirus. Everyone can do their part to help us respond to this emerging public health threat:

- Please take reasonable efforts to stop the spread of illness by washing hands frequently and using care to block coughs and sneezes from spreading germs to surrounding surfaces. City staff have been instructed to forego shaking hands for the time being, and this sensible change is recommended for general interactions in public.
