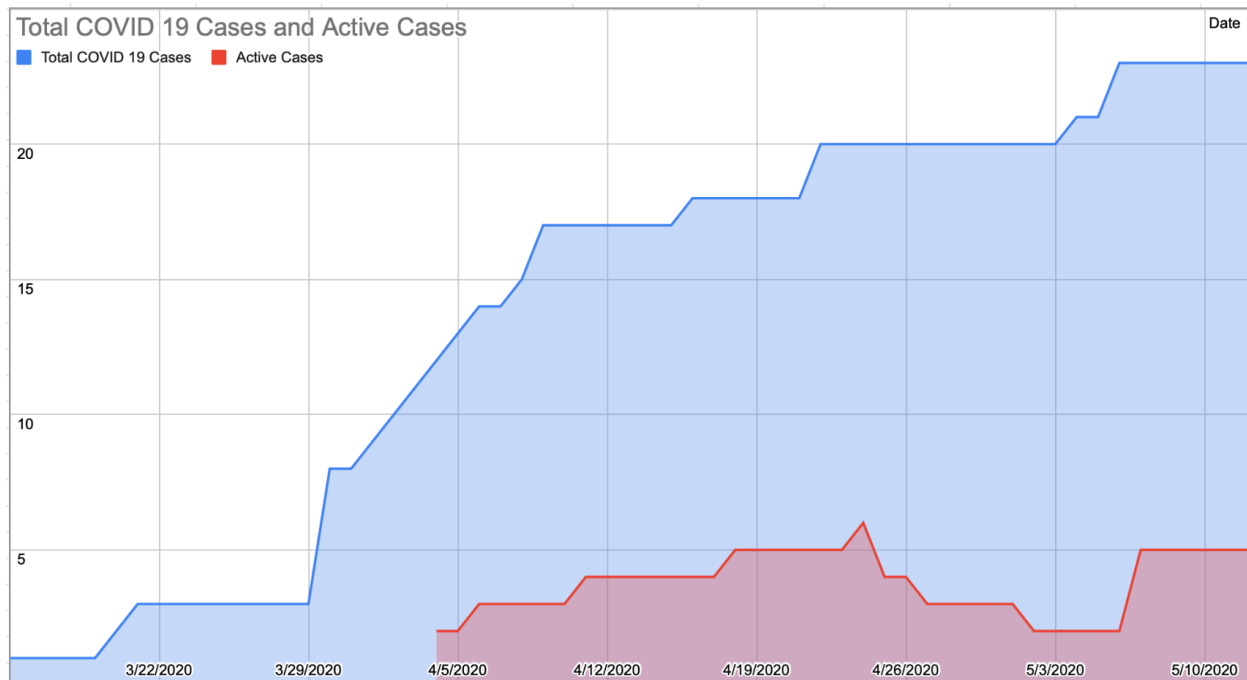

- 23 confirmed cases in Bexley / 1 confirmed death
- 3 new stats in 2 week period since last council meeting
- Of the 23 confirmed cases, 5 are currently active as of Monday

Emergency Orders Update

Section 15. Temporary Expansion of Restaurant Patios

In order to accommodate safe distancing at restaurant patios, restaurants may apply for expedited approval for temporary expansion of patio space through the Building Department.

Section 16. Solicitors Permits

No new solicitors permits shall be issued during the duration of these orders, and any solicitation with the exception of solicitation protected by the First Amendment shall be prohibited during the duration of these orders.

Operational Update

- Discussion of reduced hours for some employee groups under the Shared Work Ohio program

2020 Sidewalk Program Options

- Western third of City - restarting the cycle this year
- Estimated homeowner cost of \$97,000
- Cost for impacted residents will range from approximately \$200 to \$2,200 (uncommon to be this high)
- Wanted to explore a couple new options
 - Assessment over three years
 - Using fuel tax revenue increase to pay for homeowner sidewalks on a go-forward basis
