

# Mosquito Spraying Update

Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) confirmed that a mosquito pool set on August 9th has tested positive for West Nile Virus. They will be spraying south of Dale Avenue starting at 8:45 pm on Wednesday, August 12th, weather permitting. To see a spray map, please [click here](#).

This treatment will not impact all mosquito species which are active in Bexley. Residents should continue to be vigilant about removing sources of standing water to discourage mosquito population growth. The chemicals being used in this spraying are Permethrin and Piperonyl Butoxide.
