# Jeffrey Mansion Project secured additional \$100,000 in funding from 2020 State Capital Budget

\$100,000 was received on December 28th from the State Capital Budget. These funds will be very helpful in final project funding, and will help reduce the financial impact to the City from the project.

#### Plastic Bag Ban now in effect

Retailers are being given a couple weeks to come into full compliance; code enforcement will inspect later in January. Giant Eagle Market District is in compliance, and as far as I know we haven't received any complaints of non-compliance from other retailers.

## Sheetz development proposed for Livingston Avenue (Columbus side)

A developer has proposed a Sheetz gas station and convenience store at the southwest corner of Livingston Avenue and College Avenue in Columbus. The property would replace the Bexley Motor Car Company, the Liepzig Haus, and the Music Pallette building, and create a combined 2.47 acre site. The project requires Mid East Area Commission review and rezoning. I have reached out to the City of Columbus to get a feel for the overall timeline for all zoning and commission approvals. I'll provide an update to council on timing and process.
