From what I know to date, not one single resident near the project was ever asked for input before it being placed on the ARB Agenda. As of this morning, the neighbors that abut the project had still not received notice from the City for a 20x30 parking spaces that is scheduled to be heard on Thursday by ARB.

For the City to announce this type of project without neighborhood involvement is totally unacceptable. The City should have given neighborhood involvement even more consideration before making this type of announcement.
