Drexel Ave. We recently purchased and moved into this home last year. I wanted to indicate how important we feel choosing Option A over Option B for the future plans. I like this option given it will have less of an impact on the residents on S. Drexel Ave as it relates to parking along S. Drexel Ave.

I would also add that I have two young children who enjoy walking down Drexel and have on countless occasions chosen the crosswalk and sidewalk only to be pushed to the side by bikers with no common courtesy for pedestrians. I have not once encountered a biker on Drexel who follows the rules of the road and stops where appropriate.

If we're concerned with providing bike lanes, perhaps we could post signs directing bike traffic off of Drexel Ave to S. Columbia Ave or S. Parkview Ave.
