Your comment to the Bexley City Council:: I am writing about the proposed changes to Drexel Ave. I grew up on Drexel Ave. 354 S. Drexel and lived at 266 S. Starwood Rd. for 20 plus years. I am currently Senior Warden for St. Alban's at 333 S. Drexel Ave. My concern is that allowing parking on only one side of Drexel would negatively affect the availability of parking for church services, church meetings, and outside organizations such as AA. Could parking regulations exempt the times during church services on Sunday mornings? or Could parking be allowed after 6 pm at night? I agree with the need to make Drexel Ave. safer, but wonder if making other adjustments could be used. Having police enforce the slower speed of 25 mph, posting a "THIS IS YOUR CURRENT SPEED" sign, installing more speed limit signs, or maybe even speed bumps. St. Alban's has always been a positive influence in Bexley, but I feel limiting accessibility to parking for our parishioners would make an already limited parking problem even greater. I am asking for other solutions besides limiting parking to one side be considered.
