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In Favor of Bike Lanes on South Drexel Avenue

As a resident of the City of Bexley, especially a person who resides in a building on Drexel Avenue, I'm writing to *support* **Option B of the recommended improvements to Drexel Avenue**. I live in an apartment building near the corner of Drexel Avenue and Main Street; so I am aware of how these proposed changes would affect my daily life.

I would personally love to see protected bike lanes installed on Drexel. Having protected bike lanes would make me much more comfortable in riding through the city, whether on my personal bike or using a CoGo bike. I also want these bike lanes in order to have a clear passageway that connects to existing bike paths throughout Columbus as it would make it much easier for me to navigate and ride in peace.

Overall, I believe Option B is the better approach to improve access and safety for all roadway users of Drexel Avenue. Creating a direct north - south route connecting Bexley with other existing and future bike trails

Providing environmental benefits, reducing pollution and helping to reduce greenhouse gasses

Providing an equitable transportation option for residents and workers in Bexley resulting in economic benefits

I agree with how these benefits would support my goals. In general, creating separate, protected bike

lanes on Drexel would allow children and families to more safely bike to school, for fun, to community events and businesses; further cementing Bexley's place as one of the most livable cities in central Ohio.
