Please know that Mike and I very much support the proposed Plan B bike lane for Drexel Ave. As recent residents of Drexel Ave we were eyewitness to the daily challenges of bikes and cars trying to coexist on Drexel in the absence of any designated traffic consideration for bikes.

Sidewalks allow safe passage for pedestrians and increases accessibility which is one of the many charms that make our city a desirable place to live. A dedicated bike lane will do the same.

A dedicated bike lane on Drexel will let folks safely bike on Drexel to commerce on Drexel and Main, and City Hall. This will certainly reduce the number of cars on Drexel and relieve the demand for parking.
