Monique,

A letter dated 2/9/24 from Director Price and delivered Monday (2/12/24) to Bexley neighbors referred to proposals made for changes in Commonwealth Park access/connections, and identified an apparent move-forward process by Council.

Regardless, we want to enter further our concerns (along with many others heard Jan. 24) about the overall "park unification." It would partly reconfigure entry/exit (and daily passage) in areas that have long been existing pathways in full use through Bexley streets, adversely affecting many Bexley residents, along with increased traffic crossing from Columbus. In fact, as observers and studies reflect, there is today already increase in heavier and often ill controlled vehicle traffic along both North Drexel and North Cassady, plus more on N. Parkview. Though not all increase may relate to Bexley changes or City procedures, more complete traffic and parking studies would give better data for decision-making, and more developed reality impact (research) review.

Such factors all come together and need much additional attention and resolution BEFORE considering full City action. Unfortunately for us the last 3 days of Feb. we are scheduled out of the city & are not available to attend the proposed Council hearing/reading on Feb. 27.

However, via this note to your email, we would like the possibility of finding a few minutes informally to visit with you soon (nearby in Bexley) when you may have some time, simply to confer a little more on process that seems incomplete on the larger issues.
