To prevent disorderly conduct in the ~~Village~~^{city} of Bexley,
Ohio.

Be it ordained by the Council of the ~~Village~~^{city} of Bexley,
Ohio:-

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person within
the limits of the Village to allow his or her house, shop, store,
saloon or other place to be used, frequented or resorted to by
any rioters, noisy or disorderly persons or by any gamblers
or vagrants or permit any boisterous, noisy or disorderly con-
duct therein or thereof to the disturbance or annoyance of the
neighborhood or the public or to make or assist or countenance
or abet the making of any riot, row, noise, disorder or disturb-
ance at any house, store, shop or saloon, street, alley or place
whatsoever in the ~~Village~~^{city}.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of
Sec. 1 shall upon conviction thereof before the Mayor be fined
in any sum not less than one dollar and not more than fifty
dollars.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after its passage and legal publication.
