

To prevent disorderly conduct in the Village of Bexley. Ohio.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, Ohio:-

It shall be unlawful for any person within Section 1. the limits of the Willage to allow his or her house, shop, store, salcon or other place to be used, frequented or resorted to by any rioters, noisy or disorderly persons or by any gamblers or vagrants or permit any boisterous, noisy or disorderly conduct therein or thereof to the disturbance or annoyance of the neighborhood or the public or to make or assist or counternance or abet the making of any riot, row, noise, disorder or disturbance at any house, store, shop or saloon, street, alley or place whatsoever in the Willage .

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of Sec.1 shall upon conviction thereof before the Mayor be fined in any sum not less than one dollar and not more than fifty dollars.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication.
