## AN ORDINANCE XX 2

To Prevent stock from running at large in the Village. Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, Ohio:

That it shall be unlawful for the owner, Section 1. keeper or custodian of any cattle, horses, swine, sheep, goats, geese, chickens or other fowls or animals, to permit, suffer or allow any such fowls or animals owned, kept or controlled by him to run at large within the corporate limits of the Village, and any person so offending shall, on conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not exceeding \$5.00, nor less than \$1.00 and the costs and expenses of the proceedings.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take affect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication.
