

AN ORDINANCE ~~X~~ 4

To prevent intoxication in the Village of Bexley.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley,

Ohio:-

Section 1. Any person who shall be found in a state of intoxication in any street, alley or public place within the limits of the Village shall be fined in any sum not exceeding five dollars and the cost of prosecution and shall be committed until fine and costs are paid.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication.
