MINUTES OF Council of Bexley

MEETING.

THE BUGGLES-GALE CO., COLUMBUS, O.

8-7-7

HELD Oct. 12 1909

Council meeting in regular session.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Holzman.

Role call. Members present Mr. Leonard Petzinger Goble Fishpaun. The mayor announced the appointment of Mr. Fishpaun to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Mr. Brook above appointment approved by council. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Mr. Petzinger was called for a report on the question of opening Sheridan Ave. but reported nothing had been done yet. Report accepted and case continued.

Mr. Petzinger presented a petition signed by a majority of the property owners on College Ave. requesting council to appoint someone to collect the pole tax and use the same to improve the sidewalks on College Ave.

Mayor Holzman reported that the road tax of 1908 paid to the Township Trustee would be returned to the Treasurer of Bexley as the trustee had not used any of the taxes on the roads of Bexley.

The following Drain Petition was presented by Mr. Leonard.

Bexley this Sept. 1809

To the Honorable Council of Bexley Franklin Co. Ohio.

The undersigned, owner of lots which will be drained or benefited by the improvement herein prayed for hereby make application to your honorable body, and now file with the Clerk of Bexley this, their petition, together with the plan and specifications as originally followed by the Township Trustees of Marion Township, also accompanied by estimates and profile of a survey; and now and hereby pray for the extension of the drain located on the north side of Main Street to its terminus; viz. a point due north of the east line of Capitol University Campus as was originally projected. The drain as originally projected is about 1900 feet long and has been completed partly by the Township Trustees of Marion Township and partly by the owners of abutting property from the place of beginning; viz. Park View Avenue over

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to a point on the east line of Mrs Elizabeth McNaughten's property, a distance of about 972 feet, leaving about 928 feet to be completed.

We petition for the extension of this ditch with the following modifications of the original plans:- First that the ditch be kept down according to the profile of the resurvey so as to render it serviceable to property owners living at the east line of the Corporation of Berley. Should it be desirable to extend it so far in the future, and second, that the cost of the ditch across Drexel Avenue (60 feet) be placed *pro rata* against the frontage of all property passed from Drexel Avenue east to the designated terminus; viz. a point due north of the East line of Capitol University Campus, for the reason that that portion of the ditch is not so deep and is to be made of only 12 inch sewer tile instead of 16 inch while owners of property lying west of Drexel Avenue are paying in proportion to their frontage only.

 Whereas, A petition has been presented to the Council of Berley for the completion of a ditch on the north side of Main Street as established a few years ago by the Township Trustee of Marin Township, the same to extend from Park View Avenue to a point directly north of the ^{east} boundary line of Capitol University Campus, and
 Whereas, The aforesaid ditch has been completed to the east boundary line of Mrs. Elizabeth McNaughten lot, a distance of about 972 feet and the completion of the remainder, a distance of about 928 feet is now prayed for. Therefore

That the aforesaid ditch be completed using sewer tile from the present terminus to Drexel Avenue to be 10 inch in diameter and from there to the eastern terminus to be 12 inch in diameter the grade throughout the portion to be completed to be 2 inches to the 100 feet; that the owners of property lying west of Drexel Ave. pay the cost in proportion to their frontage only;

That the cost of constructing the ditch across Drexel Ave. (60 feet) be added pro rata to the cost of passing the frontage of all property from Drexel Avenue to the eastern terminus, viz. a point due north of the east line of Capitol University Campus.

After a general discussion motion made by Mr. Goble that the resolution be placed on the table until the next meeting night and the mayor appoint a committee to investigate and report at the next meeting.

Yea. Goble Petzinger Tschepow. No Leonard
Motion carried. The Mayor appointed Messrs
Goble and Leonard.

The following resolution was offered by Mr. Leonard and carried by a full vote of the yeas.

Be it resolved by the Council of Bexley that the village Marshal be supplied with a proper gun for his official business.
