

ORDINANCE NO. 11

(To authorize the annexation of certain territory to the village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio.)

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio,

Sec. 1. That the annexation of the following described territory to-wit,:  
Situat in Marion Township, County of Franklin and State of Ohio, (and being all of lots Nos. ~~three~~ (3) four (4) five <sup>(5)</sup> and (6) six, not already within the corporate limits of said village) set aside to the heirs-at-law of Joseph Rudolph, deceased, in partition in the case of Barbara E. Gleach and Paulina Stoltz <sup>Plaintiffs</sup> vs. Elizabeth Rudolph et al. <sup>Defendants</sup> in the Court of Common Pleas of Franklin County, Ohio, at the September Term of said Court, in the year 1904 (see complete record of said case in said Court in Vol. 258 page 29). That portion of said lots lying outside and East of said village of Bexley, (hereby sought to be annexed to said village) comprises a tract of about twenty one (21) acres of land, more or less, in the south west corner of Section No. 18 Township 5 Range 22 Refuge Lands so called, and being a portion of the premises deeded by Henry Schlitt to Joseph Rudolph by deed of February 2, 1850 and recorded in Sec. 4. Deed Record 42 page 39, be and the same is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That Dewitt C. Jones Attorney-at law be authorized to prosecute the necessary legal proceedings, to effect the annexation of said territory to said village, provided however that said attorney is to look to the heirs of said Joseph Rudolph, who own said lands so to be annexed to said village, for compensation in that behalf, and not to the village of Bexley.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
